Troika Program Attendance Policy

1) Professional Development Opportunity for Fellow Faculty Members

CCID encourages any faculty or staff from CCID member /Troika participating or non-participating/ colleges to attend any of our Troika programs as a professional development opportunity. Faculty interested in participating in the program as an “Observer”, however, needs to notify CCID Office or Lead Program Instructor of their interest to join the program well in advance of the program. This is in order to familiarize themselves with the program content and objectives as well as to get to know other faculty on the program, and understand the program’s timeline. A discussion of Observer faculty’s role during the program needs to take place in advance to ensure proper dynamics among the faculty and students attending the program. Also faculty should be able to maximize their professional development benefits from participating in the program.

2) Family Members and Friends

On a few occasions, either participating faculty or students request that they bring along a companion with them on the Troika program. CCID understands the rationale behind such request, however, due to the academic nature of the program, it is best that no companions (including spouses, children, siblings or friends) be brought on the program if they have no direct academic interest or benefit while participating in the program.
